### **Abstract**

This seminar will focus on resources and tools available from the University at Buffalo Libraries to support research activities in mechanical and aerospace engineering. Specific emphasis will be placed on the availability and use of electronic research databases, electronic journals, digital books and dissertations, and cited author and reference searching. Time permitting, an overview of EndNote, a software tool for bibliographic reference management, will be presented.
